Time	Activity	Volunteer Duties
10:00 - 10:30 AM	Children Sign-In Free Time/Quiet Time	<p><b>Teachers</b> will use this time period to prep materials needed for worship, bible lesson, and activities.</p> <p><b>Helpers</b> will assist with the sign-in process and welcome all the children and their family.</p> <p><b>Nursery</b> volunteer will organize the room and clean all the toys.</p>
10:30 – 10:45 AM	Bathroom Break Snack Time	<p><b>Teachers</b> will set up and start passing out the snacks.</p> <p><b>Helpers</b> will take the children to use the bathroom/ hand sanitizer, and then assist with the snack time.</p>
10:45 – 11:00 AM	Prayer and Worship Time	<b>Teacher</b> leads worship time and <b>Helper</b> manages the classroom atmosphere.
11:00 AM – 12:00 PM	Bible Lesson Arts and Crafts, Games, Drama, other activities, etc.	<b>Teacher</b> leads the bible story and any activities planned for Sunday service, while the <b>Helper</b> interacts with the children and assist with supplies/materials.
12:00 – 12:15 PM	Closing prayer time Clean-Up Sign-Out	<p><b>Big Kids</b> will end with a prayer time with the prayer tree activity and praying for one another, while <b>Nemo</b> room will have a closing prayer time.</p> <p><b>Everyone</b> will help clean up the classroom and the <b>Helper</b> will assist with the sign-out procedures.</p>

#### **Cognitive Development**

- Music can also assist with memorization
- Use one-to-one correspondence skills

#### **Social Development**

- Interacting with others
- Learning to cooperate

#### **Emotional Development**

- Music helps to create and manipulate moods

#### **Motor Development**

- Improves fine motor skills, coordination, and rhythm.
- Music enhances children's ability to sequence sound, recognize and respond to rhythm patterns
- Increase coordination, flexibility, and motor skills

#### **Language Development**

- Music is a form of communication
- Assists in speech
- Can also help children develop fluency, pronunciation, enunciation, and vocabulary
